1. Reference (a) NAVSEADET RASO technical assistance visit report on Naval Supply Depot, Guam indicated that a formal radiation safety program has not been promulgated as required by reference (b).


2. NSD Guam questions the requirement to appoint a Radiation Safety Officer and establish a formal radiation safety program. Request your assistance in identifying what part of paragraph I.D.3 of reference (b) was used to establish our non-compliance.

3. Paragraph I.D.3 of reference (b) sets the following criteria for requiring appointment of a qualified Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and establishing a formal Radiation Safety Program. The activity:

- a. Receive, store, ship, use, transport, or dispose of radioactive material requiring a specific NRC license;
- b. Conduct x-ray analytical or radiographic operations; or
- c. Use accelerators.

4. This depot does not conduct x-ray analytical or radiographic operations nor use accelerators. Therefore, it is assumed that subparagraph 3.a above was used to determine non-compliance. If our non-compliance relates to subparagraph a above, request your assistance in identifying the items that require a specific NRC license that this NSD receives, stores, ships, uses, transports or disposes of.

5. In view of expense of meeting requirements stipulated in paragraph I.D.3 of reference (b), NSD Guam wishes to avoid such expenses if possible.
