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

1. As requested in reference (a), plan for implementation of radiation safety program was forwarded in reference (b).
2. Reference (c) informed NSD Guam that reference (b) proposed action is adequate.
3. To date, the following action has been taken:
 - a. A formal radiation safety program has been promulgated. NSD RSO is Mr. Antonio Y. Taianao.
 - b. A complete evaluation of Warehouses 2 and 9 was conducted by RSO.
 - c. RSO evaluation reveals that the amount of material and radiation exposure is minimal and well below the standard which requires personnel monitoring devices or health monitoring.
 - d. All warehouse workers involved in the handling of radiation material have been trained.
 - e. NRC regulations have been posted in Warehouse 2 and 9 safety bulletin boards.
4. Standard operating procedure is presently being prepared by RSO. It is expected that full program implementation will be accomplished within two weeks.
